



Exemption(s) by Flag Administration:

Navigation light arrangements as detailed in drawings 7-6040-6-03-01 Rev. A-PE and 7-6040-6-03-02 Rev. A-PE not fully meeting the requirements Part 14.7.1 of the Consolidated Edition 2001 of the MODU Code are agreed for transit conditions.

Exemption is granted from MODU Code Ch 10, Para 10.11.1 requirement to provide one immersion suit per person whist operating between latitudes 25 deg north and 25 deg south. Six immersion suits are provided in accordance with the vessels Life Saving Plan.
